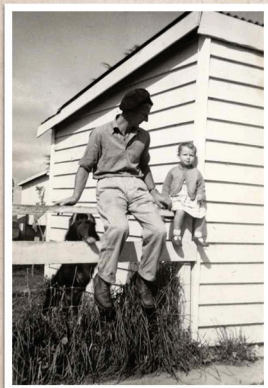
Les Thompson's Story

For 45 hardworking years, he worked on farms in Glenham and Pine Bush, initially in partnership with his father and later with Lesley.

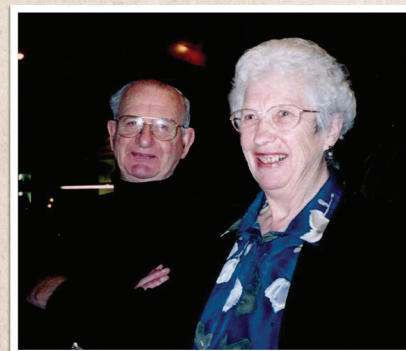
